



GROWSMART 2012 – SUMMARY OF COMPETITION RULES

The following is a summary of the main rules of the competition. Any amendments to these rules may only be made by the Growsmart organisers.

1. Participation in Growsmart 2012 is limited to the 168 selected schools, as per the attachment.
2. The schools will conduct their own competition to select a team of three learners from the pool of learners in Grades 4, 5 and 6 to compete in Growsmart.
3. Team members must remain the same throughout the competition. If it becomes impossible for a team member to continue and the school needs to replace that team member, such a request must be lodged with the organisers of Growsmart and will be duly considered.
4. Teams must arrive at the competition venue punctually when due to compete. Teams arriving more than 10 minutes late may be disqualified.
5. Each team will have a Mentor responsible for coordinating Growsmart at their school and ensuring that the team is prepared. The Mentor will arrange for the necessary documentation to be signed by the learners' parents and will arrange for the team members to be transported to and from the competition venues.
6. All necessary information regarding the team's participation will be communicated to the Mentor.

7. It is the responsibility of schools to ensure that all necessary documentation has been completed and returned to the Growsmart project team by the due date or risk being disqualified from the competition. These include the relevant indemnity and permission forms, as well as the wish lists for the schools and learners. If there are any doubts, the school must contact Mark Jonker to check their status.
8. Growsmart will be conducted over three competition levels:
 - a. **Level One** – All 168 schools have an opportunity to compete in this level. There will be 42 schools from each of the Districts East, South, North and Central. Of these, 7 schools from each District will progress to Level Two and the rest will be eliminated from the competition.
 - b. **Level Two** – 28 schools will compete in this level. 8 schools will advance to Level Three.
 - c. **Level Three** – This is the final level. The final 8 schools will comprise of all 4 District.

In the final round, 3 teams will be eliminated and the surviving 3 teams will continue to determine the overall winner, as well as second and third places.
9. Prior to each competition round, the schools will receive a Growsmart newspaper which they must read and use for preparation. Words will be selected from these newspapers for use in the competition.
10. The structure of the competition rounds will remain the same throughout the competition.
11. Each competition round will be supervised by a panel of Judges, Scorekeepers and a Quizmaster. The Judges' decision is final.

12. The Quizmaster will explain the rules at the beginning of each competition round and will present the questions to the teams.
13. Teams will be required to spell the word, correctly use the word in a sentence and to provide the correct definition of the word. Each of these three tasks must be carried out by a different team member.
 - a. It will be the team's responsibility to ensure they understand the word that they are required to spell.
 - b. They may ask questions to obtain clarity in this regard.
 - c. The three tasks will be rotated with each new word, starting with the team member on the left (with the team facing you) – that member will spell the word, the next member will define the word and the member on the right will use it in a sentence. The middle member will spell the next word, etc.
14. Teams will earn points based on their answers. The team with the most points will be the winner of that round.
15. A component of each competition round will include the use of buzzers. The team pressing their buzzer first will get to answer a question. However, some teams tend to press the buzzer before the question is heard. If a team presses a buzzer and they get the question wrong, points will be deducted from the team's tally. This is the only part of the competition where points will be deducted for incorrect answers.
16. The Scorekeepers will maintain and update the scores for each team during the competition rounds.
17. The panel of Judges will be responsible for general oversight and will have the final say as to whether or not a question has been correctly or incorrectly answered. Teams may be disqualified from continuing in the competition if the Judges agree that they are not eligible to compete, that they have not followed the competition rules or that their behaviour has been generally unacceptable.
18. The selection of the words used in the competition by the Quizmaster will be the responsibility of the Growsmart organisers.
